It's a Beautiful Day in the Cimarron Woods Neighborhood

I hope everyone is enjoying spring time in Nebraska where it is 70 degrees and sunny one day and 30 degrees and snowing the next day. If mother nature is kind to us, there will be no more snow. Each year, the SID board arranges to have the streets cleaned of all the sand and debris left over from the winter. This started last week (04/01 – 04/05) and will continue into this week (04/08 – 04/12).

By now, you should have received your 2013 HOA dues letter requesting payment of the \$100 fee. Last year, we experienced mailing problems where random houses did not receive their first mailing notification. Therefore, if you did not receive the mailing, we ask that you remit \$100 by May 1st to Cimarron Woods West HOA, 10142 Josephine Ave., La Vista, NE 68128.

As specified in the letter, your dues are used to maintain common Lots A & B which include watering, mowing, fertilizing, etc. Also, the dues go towards island maintenance which includes plant care, mulch, etc. Due to the drought last year, our landscaping company will be taking a close look at the condition of the plants on the islands. If any replacement of plants is required, this will take place in the spring. Our yearly financial records are posted to the website in order to view the yearly expenditures of the HOA.

Finally, when the park was upgraded two years ago, the area east of the playground was graded to include three practice soccer fields. Since these fields are not regulation size, they are not designed for scheduled league play. If your child is on a soccer team, they are welcome to hold practice on the fields in the park. There is no cost for the use of the fields and there is no reservation policy. They are used on a first come first serve basis.

Other Information:

- ☒ A contractor has been hired to replace bad sidewalk panels and street panels in the subdivision. Work will begin depending on weather conditions.
- ☒ The entrance islands at 104th Street and Cimarron Woods Drive will have new mulch added this year.
- ☒ The 96th reconstruction project will begin by the end of April.

La Vista Clean Up Days Scheduled for April 26-27



The City of La Vista's annual Clean-Up Days will be held on Friday, April 26 and Saturday, April 27, from 7:30am to 3:30pm.

All residents, including those in the City's two-mile zoning jurisdiction, are encouraged to take advantage of this free disposal service by bringing discarded items to the Public Works facility, 9900 Portal Road.

Examples of items that will be accepted include major appliances, lawn and household furniture, toys, bikes, lawn mowers, grills and mattresses. There will be a separate dumpster to collect yard waste, leaves and grass clippings.

Tree branches will be accepted if their diameter is less than six inches. Motor oil and anti-freeze will be accepted but not be free of debris. Household and car batteries will also be accepted. Paint, tires and hazardous waste will not be accepted.

In addition, document shredding services will be provided from 10 a.m. to noon, on Saturday, April 27. The shredding is limited to three boxes per household. Documents will be shredded on site and staples and paper clips do not need to be removed.

Proof of residency will be required; either a valid driver's license or a utility bill.
